AN ORDINANCE adopting Titles 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 46 a codification of the permanent and general ordinances of King County, Washington, and repealing Ordinances 1160, 1129,

1002 and 950 and K.C.C. Code Adoption Sections 1-15.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

ORDINANCE NO.

SECTION 1. Ordinances 1160, 1129, 1002 and 950 and K.C.C. Code Adoption Sections 1-15, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Adoption. Pursuant to the requirement of King County Charter Section 880, Titles 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 46 of the "King County Code", dated 1981, as compiled by King County Council staff, a codification of permanent and general ordinances of King County, are hereby adopted.

SECTION 3. Title--Citation--Reference. This code shall be known as the "King County Code" and it shall be sufficient to refer to said code as the "King County Code" in any prosecution for the violation of any provision thereof or in any proceeding at law or equity. It shall be sufficient to designate any ordinance adding to, amending, correcting or repealing all or any part or portion thereof as an addition to, amendment to, correction or repeal of the "King County Code". Further, reference may be had to the titles, chapters, sections and subsections of the "King County Code" and such reference shall apply to that numbered title, chapter, section or subsection as it appears in the code.

SECTION 4. Rules of Construction. The adoption of this code shall establish the laws of King County of a general and permanent nature in effect as of the effective date of this ordinance, except that nothing herein shall be construed as changing the meaning of any such laws and, as a rule of construction, in case of any omissions or any inconsistency between any of the provisions of this code and the laws existing /

immediately preceding this enactment, the previously existing laws shall control.

SECTION 5. Reference applies to all amendments. Whenever a reference is made to this code as the "King County Code" or to any portion thereof, or to any ordinance of the County of King, Washington, the reference shall apply to all amendments, corrections and additions heretofore, now or hereafter made.

SECTION 6. Title, chapter and section headings. Title, chapter and section headings contained herein shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of any title, chapter or section hereof.

SECTION 7. Prohibited acts include causing, permitting.

Whenever in this code any act or omission is made unlawful, it shall also be unlawful to cause, allow, permit, aid, abet, suffer, or conceal the fact of such act or omission.

SECTION 8. Construction. The provisions of this code and all proceedings under it are to be construed with a view to effect its objects and to promote justice.

SECTION 9. Reference to specific ordinances. The adoption of this code shall not in any manner affect any specific reference to ordinances in the prior code, by number designation or otherwise, but such reference shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this code.

SECTION 10. Effect of code on past sections and obligations. Neither the adoption of this code nor the repeal or amendment hereby of any ordinance or part or portion of any ordinance of the county shall in any manner affect the prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date hereof, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee or penalty at said effective date due and unpaid under such ordinances, nor be construed as affecting any of

1 the provisions of such ordinances relating to the collection of 2 any such license, fee or penalty, on the penal provisions 3 applicable to any violation thereof, nor be construed as affecting the validity of any bond or cash deposit in lieu thereof 5 required to be posted, filed or deposited pursuant to any 6 ordinance, and all rights and obligations existing under the laws in effect immediately prior to the effective date of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect. 9

SECTION 11. Repeal shall not revive any ordinances. The repeal of an ordinance shall not repeal the repealing clause of such ordinance or revive any ordinance which has been repealed thereby.

SECTION 12. Exclusion of special ordinances. special ordinance of the county, whether or not contained in whole or in part within the code, is not affected by the adoption or operation of this code. It is the intent and purpose of this code adoption to exclude from repeal any and all ordinances not of a general nature.

SECTION 13. Effective date. This code shall become effective on the date the ordinance adopting this code as the "King County Code" shall become effective.

SECTION 14. Constitutionality. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this code is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this The council hereby declares that it would have passed this code, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
