AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as the Plemmons Annexation to King County Water District #111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Plemmons Annexation to King County Water District #111 was filed with the County Council effective March 21, 1982.
- 2. King County Water District #111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 74-2-72 concurred with the proposed annexation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District #111 of the area known as Plemmons Annexation and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on Plemmons Annexation is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as Plemmons Annexation to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 22, Range 5 East, W.M., as situated in King County, Washington. 1 2 3 Then Easterly along the North line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 21 to the East line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 21. Thence Southerly along the said East line to its intersection with a line which is 340 feet North of 6 and parallel with the South line of the North 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 21. Thence Westerly along said parallel line a distance A of 770 feet. Thence Southerly along a line which is 770 feet from and parallel with the said East line of SE 1/4 to the South line of the North 1/2 of SE 1/4 of said 9 10 Section 21. 11 Thence Westerly along said South line to the West line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 21. 12 13 Thence Northerly along said West line to the NW corner of SE 1/4 of said Section 21 and the Point 14 of Beginning.
