AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Morrison Annexation to King County Water District No. 111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Morrison Annexation to King County Water District No. 111 was filed with the County Council effective March 29, 1982.

2. King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 172-2-82 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 111 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 8, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 26th day of April, 1982, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.020.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Morrison Annexation and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on Morrison Annexation is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as Morrison Annexation to be annexed is described as follows:

The West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest
1/4 of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 5 East,
W.M.
