- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of a borrow pit along side the Woodinville-Duvall Road. A Quit Claim Deed for a public road dated August 16, 1916, shows that King County paid \$100.00 for the 100 foot by 100 foot parcel of land. The area is therefore classified "A" Class, in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works was informed that the Development Corporation will dedicate about one-half an acre of land to King County for additional right of way for the Woodinville-Duvall road. This parcel is over six times as much land as the petitioner will receive in the vacation area. Therefore, the Department of Public Works recommends that there be no square footage charge to the petitioner for this vacation request.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the subject vacation area useless as part of the County road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the $10 \, \text{M}$ day of $19 \, \text{B2}$.
