ORDINANCE NO. 6023

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$23,647 to the Grant Fund for the Pine Lake Restoration project, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$23,647 is hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from the Department of Ecology, Referendum 39 grant award for the Pine Lake Restoration Project Phase 2, Grant File No. 2061.

SECTION 2. The County Council hereby acknowledges a required in-kind match of \$7,883 by King County in support of the Pine Lake Restoration Project Phase 2.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of peace, health and safety for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
