AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste, requiring prior Council approval before King County may accept any solid waste from any public agency outside of King County; repealing Ordinance No. 6024, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6024 is hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. Any commercial establishment or industry and/or any public or private hospital or institution and/or any other public or private agency or agencies desiring to use official King County refuse or disposal facilities shall first make arrangements satisfactory to the King County Director of Public Works and Transportation for use of such facilities and comply with the service fees required under Chapter 10.12 of the King County Code.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. Not withstanding the provisions of the previous Section, King County's acceptance of any public

1	agency's solid waste from outside King County shall require
2	prior Council approval by Ordinance.
