ORDINANCE NO. <u>*6061</u>

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to grant preliminary approval, subject to conditions, upon the application for a planned unit development petitioned by SPRINGFIELD CONDOMINIUMS, and designated File No. 236-81-P, and modifying Condition No. 26 and deleting Condition No. 27.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated February 19, 1982, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on March 11, 1982 to grant preliminary approval, subject to conditions, to the application for a planned unit development petitioned by SPRINGFIELD CONDOMINIUMS, designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development, File No. 236-81-P and the Council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation(s) contained in said report, with the following modifications:

Condition No. 26 is deleted and replaced with the following: 26. Final approval of this Planned Unit Development shall be given only after the applicant files with the Building and Land Development Division proof as deemed appropriate that DOT Contracts 2177 and 2185 have been issued which contract provide for the improvement of SR 515 to a four land urban section plus a turning lane between SE 196th and Carr Road.

Condition No. 27 is deleted.

SECTION 2. Upon approval of the final planned unit development plan by the Manager of the Building and Land Development Division, the Building and Land Development Division, shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action. If a final planned unit development plan which meets all the conditions of this preliminary approval is not submitted to the Manager of the Building and Land Development Division within the

time limits (as they may be extended) provided by King County Code Ch. 21.56, all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect.

SECTION 3. The conditions of this preliminary approval are binding as to the general intent and apportionment of land for buildings, stipulated uses and circulation pattern, but are not to be construed to render inflexible the ultimate design, specific uses or final plan of this project.
