ORDINANCE NO. 6065

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$144,000 to the Department of Assessments from the Executive Contingency for the valuation of new construction, amending Ordinance No. 5757, Section 36 and 37, as amended, and declaring an emergency

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$144,000 to the Department of Assessments, Current Expense Fund, to value all new construction.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 36, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ((\$374,001)) \$230,001 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.
