ORDINANCE NO. 6089

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the Vashon Sewer District Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 179).

PREAMBLE:

On June 8, 1982, Vashon Sewer District adopted Resolution No. 179 which amends the District's Comprehensive Plan to provide for the construction of approximately 4358 feet of 8" sewer line within proposed 103rd SW from SW 176th Street to just beyond SW 188th Street to serve the "Industrial Annexation" portion of the district.

On April 27, 1982, the district issued a certificate of Categorical Exemption for the project in accordance with WAC 197-10-170.

On June 23, 1982, the proposed Comprehensive Sewer Plan Amendment was submitted to the Utility Technical Review Committee for review as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. The Committee has recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Vashon Sewer District Comprehensive Plan Amendment as adopted by District Resolution No. 179 (attached), is hereby approved.
