ORDINANCE NO. 6128

1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating an additional
2 \$72,000 to the Department of Youth Services
3 from Executive Contingency to support the
4 1982 cost of an educational program for the
County juvenile detention center and amend-
ing Ordinance 5757, Section 31, as amended.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an
7 appropriation of \$72,000 to the Department of Youth Services
8 from Executive Contingency to support the 1982 cost of an
9 educational program for the County juvenile detention center.
10 By taking this action, the County is not acknowledging final
11 responsibility for the funding of juvenile detention education.
12 The County agrees to organize and immediately fund this program
13 per the Supreme Court Decision (Tommy P. vs Spokane) during
14 the interim before the responsibility of the state is
15 established.

16 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5757, Section 36, is hereby
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Special Programs ~~(+\$2,561,237)~~ \$2,489,237

19 Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of
20 ~~((+\$100,629))~~ \$36,629 which shall not be expended unless the
21 County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available
22 and requests the County Council adopt an additional appropriation
23 ordinance, upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the
24 purpose specified.
