ORDINANCE NO. 6130

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation of The City of Des Moines to King County Fire Protection District No. 26 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Des Moines, by Ordinance No. 547, has found that it is essential and necessary for the protection and health, life and property of the residents of the City and that it is in the public interest of the residents of the City that the City annex to and become a part of King County Fire Protection District No. 26 in accordance with RCW 52.04.170 through .190.

SECTION 2. Said Ordinance does satisfy the provisions of RCW 52.04.170 for qualification for annexation.

SECTION 3. King County Fire Protection District No. 26, by Resolution No. 961-5-25, concurs in the annexation of the City of Des Moines to the District in accordance with RCW 52.04.170 thru .190.

SECTION 4. The King County Boundary Review Board, by its decision dated July 30, 1982, approved the proposal as submitted, all in accordance with RCW 36.93.100.

SECTION 5. A special election in accordance with RCW 52.04.180 shall be held on the 2nd day of November, 1982, or at the next special election date as provided by law, to be held in the City of Des Moines and the King County Fire Protection District No. 26.
