AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation to the City of Lake Forest Park; amending Ordinance No. 6048, Section 4 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6048, Section 4, is hereby amended as follows:

A special election shall be held on the 14th day of September 1982, or at the next special election date as provided by law, within the territory of the proposed annexation, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the said territory the proposition of annexation ((and assumption-of indebtedness)) to the City of Lake Forest Park.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 23rd day of August, 1982.
