ORDINANCE NO. 6138

AN ORDINANCE relating to the consolidation of King County Water Districts Nos. 69, 77, and 88, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the consolidation of King County Water Districts Nos. 69, 77, and 88 was filed with the County Council effective September 9, 1982.
- 2. King County Water Districts Nos. 69, 77, and 88 have adopted a Consolidation Agreement by joint resolution.
- 3. King County Water Districts Nos. 69, 77, and 88 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated February 22, 1982, on the proposed consolidation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 13th day of Leptember, 1982, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The consolidation of King County Water Districts Nos. 69, 77, and 88 and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to a special election to be held among the voters of each of the consolidating districts.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 2}}$. The area to be consolidated is described as follows:

Those portions of Section 12 and 13 of T23N, R4E, W.M., in King County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of 78th Avenue South with the North line of Walker's Highland View Addition as recorded in Volume 59 of Plats, Page 2, Records of King County;

THENCE Southerly along said centerline of 78th Avenue South to its intersection with the centerline of South 120th Street;

THENCE Easterly along said centerline of South 120th Street to its intersection with the centerline of 79th Avenue South;
