ORDINANCE NO. 6156

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$41,685 to the Public Health Pooling Fund from Federal Sources, for the purpose of providing services through the Seattle Indian Health Board, amending Ordinance No. 5757, Section 51, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$41,685 is hereby appropriated to the Public Health Pooling Fund from Federal grant sources for the purposes of providing services through the Seattle Indian Health Board.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 5757, Section 51, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:
