AN ORDINANCE relating to gambling; clarifying liability for penalties; and amending Ordinance No. 2041, Sec. 4, and K.C.C. 12.54.040.

PREAMBLE:

The Council of King County desires to clarify the expression of its intent that responsible agents of associations and organizations which violate the provisions of Ordinance No. 2041, K.C.C. Chapter 12.54, concerning taxation of gambling, are guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2041, Section 4, and K.C.C. 12.54.040,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

officers, directors and managers of any association or organization conducting gambling activities shall be jointly and severally liable for the payment of the tax required by this chapter and for any penalties imposed hereunder. Any person who fails or refuses to pay the tax ((hereinbefore)) required by this chapter, or who wilfully disobeys any rule or regulation promulgated by the comptroller hereunder, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety days or by a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars or both. Any such fine shall be in addition to the tax required. ((Officers, directors and managers of any organization conducting gambling activities
