ORDINANCE NO: 6175

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of DAVID P. MAHLMAN, designated Building and Land Development File No. 230-82-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the September 22, 1982 and September 29, 1982 reports of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on October 14, 1982, on the application of DAVID P. MAHLMAN to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 230-82-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR to RM 1800-P subject to conditions (modified) is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within two years of Council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
