

ORDINANCE NO. 6196

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Fair Board, expanding the membership of the Fair Board to add a representative from the City of Enumclaw, amending Ordinance 4092, Section 1, and K.C.C. 2.32.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 4092, Section 1, and K.C.C. 2.32.040 are hereby amended as follows:

FAIR BOARD. A. It is the intent of the King County council to reduce the administrative workload of the King County fair board to clarify the relationships between, and responsibilities of, the County and the fair board. The King County fair board is hereby designated the following responsibilities:

1. To provide recommendations, advice and assist in the planning and conduct of the King County fair;
2. To function as a vital point of interface between King County and, a. the citizenry of the County, and b. key participating groups upon whose participation a successful fair depends;
3. To actively participate in the activities of the fair, particularly with respect to the agricultural and youth-oriented events and activities of the fair;
4. To serve in a liaison capacity with participating groups and officials in the King County fair;
5. To make recommendations on the proposed King County fair budget;
6. The board is authorized and encouraged to communicate directly with the county executive, the county council, and the director of the Department of Planning and Community Development and the manager of the Parks Division at its discretion. Such action is particularly encouraged in those instances where the

1 board considers that its policies or recommendations are not
2 being followed.

3 B. ((1+)) The King County fair board shall consist of the
4 following members, all of whom shall vote except as noted:

5 ((a+)) 1. Nine members each representing a council
6 district shall be selected by the county executive from a list
7 of one or more nominees presented to him by the councilman
8 representing that district.

9 a. In the event that no nominees are submitted for the
10 district within thirty days from the effective date of the
11 vacancy, the county executive may make his/her own selection;

12 b. The terms of office for the member from each council
13 district shall be for a three year period commencing October 1.

14 ((b+)) 2. The Director of the King County Extension
15 Service, or his designee;

16 ((e+)) 3. One member selected by the King County
17 Vocational Agriculture Instructors' Organization (Future Farmers
18 of America);

19 ((d+)) 4. Two members selected by the members of the King
20 County 4-H Leader's Council;

21 ((e+)) 5. Two youth members; one appointed by the
22 agriculture teachers from the membership of the FFA and one
23 appointed by the King County extension agent from the membership
24 of 4-H;

25 6. One representative from the City of Enumclaw to be
26 appointed by the Mayor of the City of Enumclaw and confirmed by
27 the Enumclaw City Council.

28 ((2+--The-terms-of-office-for-the-member-from-each-council
29 district-shall-be-for-a-three-year-period-commencing-October-1+))

30 C. The King County Fair is designated the line
31 responsibility of the Department of Planning and Community
32 Development, Parks Division. Direct operating authority and
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1 responsibilities concerning the fair rest with the Parks
2 Division.

3 D. The King County fair board shall recommend at least
4 three candidates for the position of fair manager to the manager
5 of the Parks Division. The manager of the Parks Division shall
6 appoint the fair manager after considering the Board's
7 recommendation. The King County fair manager will report
8 directly to the manager of the Parks Division. The position
9 will be exempt from career service. The fair manager shall
10 attend all regular meetings of the King County fair board and
11 keep the King County fair board informed of all developments
12 concerning the King County fair.

13 E. The King County fair manager and/or the manager of the
14 Parks Division shall consult with the King County fair board in
15 connection with the submittal of a budget for the operation of
16 the fair and fairgrounds. The proposed budget will be submitted
17 to the King County fair board whose comments and recommended
18 modifications, if any, will be included in or appended to the
19 budget documentation forwarded to the county executive and the
20 county council. No budget shall be presented for adoption which
21 cannot be shown to have reasonable expectation of operating the
22 fair, its maintenance and proposed improvements from funds
23 accruing from fair revenues.

24 F. All monies received by or on behalf of the fair shall be
25 deposited in the county treasury. All expenditures incurred in
26 operation of the county fair and fair board shall be in
27 accordance with procedures, ordinances and general laws
28 governing the financial administration of King County.
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1 G. Capital improvements to the King County fairgrounds at
 2 Enumclaw, Washington, shall be paid for from revenues generated
 3 by the fair from other than the county current expense fund,
 4 unless otherwise provided by ordinance. The use of bonds for
 5 purposes of capital improvements may be proposed, subject to
 6 approval of the King County executive and thereafter upon review
 7 and approval of the county council. No substantial change in
 8 land use at the King County fairgrounds or adjacent property
 9 will be made without the express approval of the King County
 10 council.
