

ORDINANCE NO. 6205

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$11,000 to the Civil Service Commission from the Executive Contingency to support an assessment center element in the promotional examinations for the positions of lieutenant and captain in the Department of Public Safety, amending Ordinance No. 5757, Section 14, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$11,000 from the Executive Contingency is hereby approved and adopted for the Civil Service Commission to support an assessment center element in the promotional examinations for the positions of lieutenant and captain in the Department of Public Safety.
