ORDINANCE NO. 6214

AN ORDINANCE approving a Water Comprehensive Plan to serve 55 existing five acre lots east of Maple Valley.

PREAMBLE:

On August 2, 1982, Subdivision Management, Inc., submitted the Comprehensive Water Plan Maplewood Estates to the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) for approval.

On September 22, 1982, the UTRC recommended conditional approval of a water plan to serve 55 existing five acre lots within the proposed subdivision of Maplewood Estates.

On March 26, 1982, a Declaration of Non-Significance was filed by King County for this proposal.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A comprehensive Water Plan to serve only the existing 55 lots within the proposed development of Maplewood Estates is hereby approved, PROVIDED that; sufficient storage is installed to meet minimum DSHS standards for equalizing and standby storage.

SECTION 2. Design, pipe sizing and material specifications shall be compatible with Water District No. 108 standards and

2 and the property owner assuring such compatibility shall be  
3 submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee.
