

ORDINANCE NO. 6215

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the Dockton Water Association Comprehensive Water System Plan (Revised September 7, 1982 Edition).

PREAMBLE:

The Board of Directors of the Dockton Water Association adopted the Comprehensive Water System Plan by Resolution on July 16, 1982.

On October 1, 1982 King County filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed Water System Plan.

On August 12, 1982 the Dockton Comprehensive Water System Plan was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee, as required by KCC 13.24. On September 8, 1982 the Utilities Technical Review Committee recommended conditional approval of the revised Dockton Comprehensive Water System Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Dockton Water Association Comprehensive Water System Plan (Revised September 7, 1982, 1982 Edition) is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

A. Water mains and fire hydrants shall be installed consistent with the provisions of KCC 17.08.

B. The Association shall submit to the Utilities Technical Review Committee by December 31, 1982, and annually thereafter, a report on:

1. The progress in implementing the planned system improvements.

- 1 2. The total number of customers that are being served.
- 2 3. The status of any merger or absorption plans with
- 3 other water systems.
