- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 40th Avenue South, hereinafter described.

- 3. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements have been secured by Puget Sound Power & Light Company, Pacific Northwest Bell Company and Washington Natural Gas.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Rancho Vista No. 6 which was recorded in King County records on March 18, 1959. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is therefore classified "C" Class, in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 6+h day of Alcember, 1982.
