ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS-67 to Des Moines Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS-67 to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective October 25, 1982.
- 2. Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 1982-26 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated September 22, 1982, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 13th day of December, 19 82, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS-67 and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on DS-67 is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
