- 1. Implement a budgeting system for public defense service contractors which promotes consistency in budgeting among defender organizations by establishing uniform expenditure and revenue accounts.
- 2. Develop categories of defender organizations' expenditures that are eligible for inclusion in defender organizations' budget base.
