ORDINANCE NO. 6259

AN ORDINANCE relating to King County  
Worker's Compensation Fund; repealing  
Ordinance No. 1466 and Ordinance No. 1560.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1466 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1560 is hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. There is hereby established under  
the provisions of Chapter 51.14 of the Revised Code of  
Washington, a self insurance reserve fund which shall be known  
as the King County Worker's Compensation Fund. Said fund shall  
serve as the depository and serving account of funds necessary  
to fulfill those purposes contained in Chapter 51.14.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. This fund is intended to collect  
and disburse monies to carry out the functions of the Safety and  
Worker's Compensation program, and funds shall not be attached  
for other purposes, unless such action is expressly approved by  
the Council.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. Industrial insurance rates shall  
be established such that sufficient revenues shall accrue to the  
fund to pay for the cost of the program functions and to  
maintain a positive fund balance. Such rates shall take into  
consideration, but may be limited to the following factors:

1 past losses for each industrial insurance classification, the  
2 number of hours worked in each classification, and estimated  
3 claims settlements for injury claims.

4 NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. The Director of Executive  
5 Administration is hereby authorized to transfer from the budget  
6 of each county department at the end of each fiscal quarter a  
7 sum of money that represents the amount of money previously  
8 budgeted for payment of state industrial insurance.

9 NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. The County Executive is hereby  
10 authorized to obtain for the county whatever bond is required by  
11 law to become a self-insurer under Chapter 51.14.

12 NEW SECTION. SECTION 8. It is intended that the policies  
13 contained in this ordinance be applied to the Worker's  
14 Compensation Fund beginning in 1982.
