AN ORDINANCE confirming the revised assessment roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 75 for improvements to a portion of South West 340th Street and South West 336th Street in the Woodridge Park area of King County.

PREAMBLE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY;

SECTION 1. The Council, sitting as a board of equalization and having made all revisions to the roll it deems necessary, hereby finds that the revised assessment roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 75 (hereinafter "RID 75") is just and equitable and that no revised assessment against any property within RID 75 is greater than the special benefits to be derived from the improvement made to such property.

Accordingly, said revised assessment roll, totaling \$244,912.97, is hereby confirmed and the revised assessments set forth therein are hereby levied against each parcel of property described in said roll.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to place in the hands of the King County Comptroller for collection the revised assessment roll for RID 75, bearing such revisions as the Council has made thereto. Upon such placement, the amount of each revised assessment set forth therein, together with any interest accrued from time to time thereon and any penalty imposed from time to time thereon, shall become a lien

against the property so assessed. Said lien shall be paramount and superior to any other lien or encumbrance whatsoever, theretofore and thereafter created, except for a lien for general taxes.

SECTION 3. Upon receipt of the revised assessment roll for RID 75, the King County Comptroller is hereby directed to publish notice at the times and in the manner required by RCW 36.88.270, stating that such reassessments or any portion thereof may be paid without interest in the 30 days following first publication of such notice, and that all prior payments of principal and interest on the original assessments on property within RID 75 will be credited against the principal amount of the revised assessments on such property.

SECTION 4. The amount of any revised assessment or any portion thereof against property in RID 75 not paid within the 30-day period specified in Section 3 of this ordinance shall be paid in twenty (20) equal, annual and consecutive installments, together with interest on the diminishing principal balance of such assessment which will be set at one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) higher than the net effective interest rate on the bonds which will be sold to pay the costs of the improvements on RID 75. The actual rate will not be determined until the bonds are sold, but it is expected that the assessment interest rate will be in excess of fourteen percent (14%). Interest shall commence on the thirtieth day following first publication of the Comptroller's notice described in Section 3 hereof and the first installment shall be due one year from said date. Following expiration of 30 days after said first publication, the principal balance of the assessment, together with accrued interest and penalty, if any, may be prepaid only at the times and in the manner determined by the King County Comptroller.

Any installment which is not paid when due is therefore delinquent. Thereafter, such delinquent installment shall bear a penalty equal to ten percent of the principal amount of such delinquent installment plus the then accrued and unpaid interest on the principal balance of the assessment from the date of delinquency until paid.
