AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Summit-Landsburg Road Petitioner: Evan D. Morris and Others V-1776

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A Petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Summit-Landsburg Road.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements have been obtained by Pacific Northwest Bell, Puget Power and the City of Kent.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "B" Class. King County is now in receipt of \$18,480.00 from the petitioner which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation area.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 7th day of 1983.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: SECTION 1. The Council on the 1th day of Hernay  $^{6}$  , hereby vacates and abandons the portion of Summit-Landsburg Road, described as follows: All that portion of Summit-Landsburg Road also known as Lake Wilderness-Danville Road, County Road No. 1930, in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington, lying Northeasterly of the Easterly and Northerly right of way margin of the intersection of SR 169 and Kent-Kangley Road as shown on that certain drawing of Washington State Department of Transportation, SR 169 - MP 11.21 to MP 11.57 - Junction. SR 516 Vicinity. Right of way Plan - sheet 2 of 2 sheets. Vacation area contains approximately 84,000 square feet.
