

ORDINANCE NO. 6311

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District 42 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On October 27, 1982, Water District 42 filed a Proposed Declaration of Non-Significance for the adoption of a Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On November 1, 1982, Water District 42 passed Resolution No. 82-11 adopting the district's Comprehensive Water System Plan (August, 1982).

On November 24, 1982, Water District 42 submitted the adopted Comprehensive Water System Plan to King County pursuant to Chapter 57.16 RCW and KCC Chapter 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan and on November 24, 1982 recommended its approval subject to the condition that Water District 42 and Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District (NELWS&WD) construct one or more interties between the Water District 42 492 pressure zone and the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District 489 pressure zone.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 42 Comprehensive Water System Plan as adopted by District Resolution 82-11 (attached) is hereby approved. Water District 42 and Northeast Lake
