

ORDINANCE NO. 6323

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance 6300 reclassifying certain property upon the application of JOHN FENTON (File No. 256-81-R).

PREAMBLE:

On January 24, 1983, at the Land Use Appeals Hearing, the King County Council passed an amended ordinance reclassifying property of John Fenton (File No. 256-81-R) from SR (7200) to RMHP-P. Because of the conditions placed upon the reclassification, Mr. Fenton by a letter dated January 26, 1983 requested that his application be withdrawn. Since the amended ordinance had already been passed by the Council, the ordinance must now be repealed prior to the effective date in order to allow Mr. Fenton to withdraw the application.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6300 reclassifying certain property upon the application of John Fenton (File No. 256-81-R) is hereby repealed.




