ORDINANCE NO'.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS-17R to Des Moines Sewer District.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS-17R to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the County effective February 2, 1983.
- 2. Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1983-10 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated January 26, 1983, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the <u>28+h</u> day of <u>40</u>, 1983, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 2. The Des Moines Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

 $\underline{\sf SECTION 4}.$  The area known as DS-17R to be annexed is described as follows:

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That portion of Sections 17, 20, and 21, Township 22 North, Range 4 East W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 21;

Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 21 to its intersection with the centerline of 18th Avenue South;

Thence Southerly along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of South 241st Street;

Thence Westerly along said centerline of South 241st Street to its intersection with the West line of said Section 21;

Thence Northwesterly to the intersection of the West margin of 16th Avenue South with the North line of the South 15 feet of Lot 15, Block 1, of Des Moines Water Front Addition, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 4 of plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along said West margin to the North line of Lot 9, said Block 1,;

Thence Westerly along said North line and its extension and the North line of Lot 9, Block 2 said Des Moines Waterfront Addition to the Northeast corner of, College Place, accoding to plat thereof recorded in volume 70 of plats, page 62, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along the North line of said College Place and its extension to the Southeast corner of Lot 8, Block 5, said Des Moines Water Front Addition;

Thence Westerly along the South line of said Lot 8, to the West line of said Block 5;

Thence Northerly along said West line and its extension to the South line of said Section 17;

Thence Easterly along said South line to its intersection with a line 400 feet Westerly of and parallel with the East line of said Section 17;

Thence Northerly along said parallel line to its intersection with the South line of the North 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of said Section 17;

Thence Easterly along said South line to its intersection with the East line of said Section 17;

## I. BUILDING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT DIVISION REPORT:

BALD Recommendation: Approve
