STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that the vacation was recommended as a condition for final approval of Short Plat No. 481041 through 481044, and that the applicant is proposing an alternate street pattern for the property. As such, the Division would have no objection to the vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the road deeded to King County and recorded under Auditor's File No. 2601257 (Volume 1470 of Deeds, page 122) on April 21, 1930 for \$50.00. The petitioner has deeded additional right of way, including the new alignment referred to in the description below, to King County. In view of the petitioner's plan, the Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. In accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "A" Class. King County is now in receipt of \$655.96 from the petitioners, which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation area.
