ORDINANCE NO. 6379

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Standardized Salary Schedule and the annual cost-of-living increase for King County employees as stipulated in K.C.C. 3.12.130 and K.C.C. 3.12.140.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The attached King County Standardized Salary Schedule, entitled "Schedule of Pay Ranges and Steps in Annual, Monthly, and Semi-Monthly Amounts and Hourly Rates," is approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Employees of the Executive Branch and non-elected employees of the Department of Assessments, King County Superior Court and the King County Council not included in collective bargaining units shall have their salaries increased by 2.8%; except for employees holding the rank of Captain in the Department of Public Safety, those holding the rank of Lieutenant in the Department of Adult Detention, and those defined as first level supervisors in the Department of Public Works. Captains in the Department of Public Safety and Lieutenants in the Department of Adult Detention shall have their salaries increased in accordance with the terms of the 1983 police arbitration award. Assistant Supervisors in the Public Works Department shall have their salaries increased by an amount equivalent to that provide to Equipment Operator II positions covered by the Construction Crafts agreement.

Employees whose salary has been designated a Y-Rate after November 20, 1975, shall not be eligible for an increase unless their current salary falls below the new maximum (Step 10) of the pay range assigned to their position classification. Salary increases shall not be awarded that will provide a salary level in excess of Step Ten of the assigned pay range for 1983 except as may be provided by collective bargaining agreement.

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1            SECTION 3. Non-represented employees of the King County  
2 Prosecuting Attorney's Office, excluding the King County  
3 Prosecuting Attorney, shall be eligible to receive a cost-of-  
4 living adjustment determined by the Prosecuting Attorney. The  
5 amount to be applied shall be determined by increasing the aggre-  
6 gate salary base in effect prior to the effective date of this  
7 ordinance by an amount of 2.8%.

8            SECTION 4. Employees of the Division of Probation of the  
9 District Courts shall have their salaries increased by 2.8%.

10           SECTION 5. The elected office of the Prosecuting Attorney  
11 shall be compensated at the annual rate of \$62,502.50 effective  
12 January 1, 1983.

13           SECTION 6. The elected office of the King County Assessor  
14 shall be compensated at the annual rate of \$54,167.63 effective  
15 January 1, 1983.

16           SECTION 7. Should any section, subsection, paragraph,  
17 sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared  
18 unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the decision shall  
19 not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordi-  
20 nance.

21           SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be effective January 1,  
22 1983.
