- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the areas and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area, the alley lying between Blocks 87 and 88, Southern Pacific Land Co's Huntington Park Addition to Des Moines, appears to have never been open as a public road. The Plat was recorded October 25, 1889. A search of the records indicates the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C" Class in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
