AN ORDINANCE approving the Comprehensive Plan for the Walter Walker Water Works near Snoqualmie, Washington

PREAMBLE:

On April 14, 1983 submission of a Water Comprehensive Plan for the Walter Walker Water Works was completed.

On May 5, 1983, the Building and Land Development Division filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan.

On April 27, 1983 the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan and recommended its approval after making the following findings:

1. Consistent with the provisions of KCC 13.24.060, the proposed water system is necessary to serve existing and permitted uses.
2. The design of the proposed system meets requirements for water quality, quantity and reliability.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Walter Walker Water Works Plan (attached) is hereby approved.
