AN ORDINANCE transferring \$16,411 to Special Programs, System Services New Development, from Special Programs, Executive Contingency, for the continued development of the Promis 82 System, amending Ordinance No. 6253, Section 7.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$16,411 from the Special Programs Executive Contingency to Special Programs Systems Services New Development for the continued development of the PROMIS 82 system.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6213, Section 34, as amended by Ordinance No. 6253, Section 7, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs. From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS \$6,973,544

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ((\$750,000)) \$733,589 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.


PROVIDED THAT: the Executive report to the Council on the specific manpower impacts of PROMIS implementation by August 15, 1983.


