4 ORDINANCE NO. 6505

5 AN ORDINANCE relating to fees; reinstating fees  
6 for gas piping installation; amending Ordinance  
6257, Section 4 and KCC Title 16.

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6257, Section 4 and KCC Title 16.

8 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

9 Mechanical Permit Fees.

10 A. Mechanical Permit Fee Table.

11 1. For the issuance of each permit except gas

12 piping.....\$25.00

13 For the issuance of each gas piping permit.....\$18.00

14 2. Installation or relocation of each forced air or  
15 gravity-type furnace or burner, including ducts and vents  
16 attached to such appliance;

17 a. up to and including 100,000 B.t.u.'s output or  
18 29 K.W.'s.....\$25.00

19 b. over 100,000 B.t.u.'s or 29 K.W.'s through  
20 200,000 B.t.u.'s output or 58 K.W.'s.....\$33.00

21 c. each additional 10,000 B.t.u.'s output or  
22 2.9 K.W.'s over 200,000 B.t.u.'s output or 58 K.W.'s  
23 through 500,000 B.t.u.'s output or 146 K.W.'s.....\$ 2.50

24 d. each additional 10,000 B.t.u.'s output or  
25 2.9 K.W.'s over 500,000 B.t.u.'s or 146 K.W.'s.....\$ 2.50

26 NOTE: The maximum fee for conversion burners and  
27 makeup air furnaces shall be.....\$50.00

28 3. Installation or relocation of each floor  
29 furnace including vent.....\$12.50

30 4. Installation or relocation of each gas, oil or  
31 electric suspended heater, recessed wall heater or floor  
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1 mounted space heater, wall furnace, circulating heater or  
2 solid fuel burning appliance or fireplace.....(~~(\$40.00)~~) \$15.00

3 5. Installation, relocation, or replacement of each  
4 appliance when installed and not included in an appliance  
5 permit.....\$16.50

6 6. Repair of, alteration of, or addition to each  
7 heating appliance, refrigeration unit, comfort cooling  
8 unit, absorption unit, or each comfort heating, cooling,  
9 absorption, or evaporative cooling system.....\$20.00

10 7. Installation or relocation of each boiler or  
11 compressor:

12 a. to and including three horsepower, or each  
13 absorption system to and including 100,000 B.t.u.'s.....\$25.00

14 b. over three horsepower to and including 15  
15 horsepower, or each absorption system over 100,000  
16 B.t.u.'s to and including 500,000 B.t.u.'s.....\$36.00

17 c. over 15 horsepower to and including 30 horse-  
18 power, or each absorption system over 500,000 B.t.u.'s to  
19 and including 1,000,000 B.t.u.'s .....\$43.13

20 d. over 30 horsepower to and including 50 horse-  
21 power, or for each absorption system over 1,000,000  
22 B.t.u.'s to and including 1,750,000 B.t.u.'s.....\$48.00

23 e. over 50 horsepower, or each absorption  
24 system over 1,750,000 B.t.u.'s.....\$70.00

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1 NOTE: See footnotes 1 and 3 for the above listed  
2 installation.

3 8. Each air handling unit:

4 a. to and including 10,000 cubic feet per  
5 minute, including ducts attached thereto.....\$36.00

6 b. over 10,000 cubic feet per minute.....\$41.25  
7 plus \$1.00 per each additional 10,000 CFM.

8 9. Each evaporative cooler other than portable  
9 type.....\$12.38

10 10. Each ventilation fan connected to:

11 a. a single duct (see footnote 2).....\$12.38

12 b. multiple inlets.....\$18.75

13 11. Each ventilation system which is not a portion  
14 of any heating or air conditioning system authorized by  
15 a permit (see footnote 2).....\$22.50

16 12. Installation of each hood which is served by  
17 mechanical exhaust, including the ducts for such hood  
18 (see footnote 2).....\$46.88

19 13. Installation of fuel storage tanks:

20 a. first tank.....\$18.44

21 b. each additional tank.....\$ 8.13

22 \*1. For fee purposes, the following conversions shall be used.

23 a. one kilowatt equals 3,413 B.t.u.'s;

24 b. one horsepower (boiler) equals 33,000 B.t.u.'s;

25 c. one horsepower (heat pump) equals 12,000 B.t.u.'s (heat  
26 pump includes compressor).

27 \*2. Exclude Group R, Division 1 and 3 Occupancies.

28 \*3. Permits for all commercial boiler and compressor installa-  
29 tions shall be obtained from the State of Washington Department  
30 of Labor and Industries.

1 14. Installation or relocation of each  
2 commercial or industrial type incinerator.....\$41.00

3 15. Installation of gas piping (see footnote 4).

4 a. One through four outlets.....\$12.50

5 b. Additional outlets (each).....\$ 5.00

6 16. Each appliance or piece of equipment or other work  
7 regulated by this Code but not classed in other categories,  
8 or for which no other fee is listed in this Code at the  
9 rate of.....\$40.00  
10 per hour, or a minimum of.....\$20.00

11 EXCEPTION: A minimum fee of forty dollars shall be charged  
12 for those permits which are not issued in conjunction with a  
13 building permit.

14 B. FEE PAYMENT. Sixty-five percent of the mechanical per-  
15 mit fee as set forth in the table in subsection A of this sec-  
16 tion shall be paid upon application. The remainder of the fee  
17 shall be paid upon permit issuance.

18 C. REINSPECTION FEE.....\$45.00

19 D. REFUNDS.

20 1. No refund shall be made for any service already  
21 rendered.

22 2. When plan review has not been done, a refund equal to  
23 the full amount of the plan check fee less a service charge of  
24 thirty dollars.

25 3. If construction has not commenced, a refund equal to  
26 the mechanical permit fee less a service charge of thirty dollars.

27 \*4. All gas piping permits and inspections issued by Seattle/  
28 King County Health Department.  
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
1 4. When requested due to clerical error on the part of




