ORDINANCE NO. OGO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation of territory to the City of Des Moines (generally described as the South Des Moines Annexation) and assumption of indebtedness by the area proposed to be annexed; and election of members to the South Des Moines Land Use Council; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Des Moines, by resolution No. 372 has determined that the best interests and general welfare of the City would be served by the annexation of the unincorporated area described below, the legal description of which is as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Kent-Des Moines Road (SR 516) and East line of the W½ of the NE% of Section 17, Twp. 22N, R. 4E, W.M.

Thence Southerly along said East line to the North line of the SE_4 of said Section 17;

Thence continuing Southerly along the East line of the W½ of said SE¼ to the North line of King County Short Plat 479056R according to plat thereof recorded under King County Recorders File No. 8010160745;

Thence Westerly along said North line to the NW corner of said short plat;

Thence Southerly along the West line of said short plat and said
West line extended to the North line of Block 11, of Des Moines Water Front
Addition to the Town of Des Moines, according to plat thereof recorded in
Volume 4 of plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Easterly along the North line of Blocks 11, 10, 9, 8, 7 and 6 of said plat to the NE corner of said Block 6;

Thence Southerly along the East line of Block 6 and 36 said plat and said East line extended Southerly to the North line of Block 12, of First Railroad Addition to Des Moines, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 4 of plats, page 90, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along the North line of Block 12 and 13 said plat to the NW corner of Lot 1 said Block 13;

Thence Southerly along the West line of Lots 1 through 15, Block 13, Lots 1 through 15, Block 14 and Lots 1 through 15, Block 15 of said plat and

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said West line extended to the North line of Tract 7, of Wilson's Five Acre Tracts, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 11 of plats, page 9, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along said North line to the NW corner of said Tract 7;

Thence Southerly along the West line of Tract 7 and 10, said plat to the North line of the SE% of the SE% of said Section 20;

Thence Easterly along said North line and said North line extended to the East margin of 16th Avenue South;

Thence Northerly along said East margin to the North margin of South 252nd Street;

Thence Easterly along said North margin to the SW corner of Block 9, of Saltair Hills, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 59 of plats, page 39 - 41, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along the West line of Blocks 9 and 1, said plat of Saltair Hills to the NW corner of Lot 16, Block 1, said plat of Saltair Hills;

Thence Easterly along the North line of Blocks 1, 2, 3, and 4 to the NE corner of Lot 6, Block 4, said plat of Saltair Hills;

Thence N2 0 14' 14" E to the North line of the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 21;

Thence Easterly along said North line to an intersection with the Southerly projection of the West line of Block 22, Interurban Heights 3rd Section, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 17 of plats, page 87, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along the Southerly projection of and the West line of Block 22, said plat of Interurban Heights 3rd Section to the NW corner of Lot 42, Block 22 of said plat of Interurban Heights 3rd Section;

Thence Easterly along the North line of Blocks 22 and 21 and Block 21 extended, said plat of Interurban Heights 3rd Section to the intersection of the South line of Birch Street (South 246th Street) and East line of Mountain Avenue (27th Avenue South);

Thence North along the East line of said Mountain Avenue (27th Avenue South) to the North line of Lot 37, Block 17, Interurban Heights 4th Section, as recorded in Volume 17 of plats, page 86, records of King County, Washington;

Thence East along the North line of Lots 37 and 4, said Block 17 and said North line projected East to the West line of the Pacific Highway (PSH 1);

Thence northerly along said West line to intersection with the easterly extension of the South line of Lot 4, Block 7, Interurban Heights, 5th Section as recorded in Volume 17 of plats, page 85, records of King County, Washington;

Thence West along said South line of Lot 4 and its easterly extension to the East line of Yukon Avenue (28th Avenue South);

Thence North along said East line to the North line of Maple Street (South 242nd Street);

Thence West along said North line to the East line of Mountain Avenue (27th Avenue South);

Thence North along said East line to the North line of South 240th Street;

Thence East along said North line to the West line of Pacific Highway (PSH 1);

Thence North along said West line to the South line of Lot 28, Block 6, Federal Highway Addition as recorded in Volume 30 of plats, page 1, records of King County, Washington;

Thence West along said South line to the West line of said Block 6;

Thence North along the West line of said Block 6 to the North line of
Lot 23 said Block 6;

Thence East along said North line to the West line of Pacific Highway (PSH 1);

Thence North along the West line of said Pacific Highway (PSH 1) to a point 10 feet North of, at right angles to the South line of Lot 17, said Block 6;

Thence West parallel to the said South line of Lot 17 to the West line of said Block 6;

Thence Southerly along said West line to the SE corner of the NW4 of the SE4 of Section 16, Twp. 22N, R. 4E, W.M.;

Thence Westerly along the South line of said NW4 to the SE corner of the NE4 of the SW4 of said Section 16;

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Thence Westerly along the South line of said NE4 to the SW corner thereof;

Thence Northerly along the West line of said NE4 to the centerline of Kent-Des Moines Road, (SR 516);

Thence Westerly, Northwesterly, and Westerly along said centerline to the point of beginning, situated in King County, Washington.

SECTION 2. Said resolution satisfies the provisions of RCW 35A.14.015 with regard to annexation elections by resolution.

SECTION 3. Said resolution created a community municipal corporation, to be known as the South Des Moines Community Land Use Council, the members of which must be elected at the next available election.

SECTION 4. An election shall be held on the 8th day of November, 1983, concurrent with the general election of the same date, within the territory of the proposed annexation, on the following proposition if, and only if, the King County Boundary Review Board approves the annexation on or before October 7, 1983. The ballot title shall read:

Proposition One

- For annexation
- Against annexation
 (This proposition for annexation shall be void and have no effect if Proposition 2 regarding assumption of a pro-rata portion of the existing general obligation indebtedness of the City of Des Moines does not pass)

Proposition Two

- For assumption of a pro-rata portion of the existing general obligation indebtedness of the City of Des Moines.
- Against assumption of a pro-rata portion of the existing general obligation indebtedness of the City of Des Moines.

SECTION 5. An election shall be held on the 8th day of November, 1983, concurrent with the general election of that date, to select the five initial South Des Moines Community Land Use Council community municipal corporation members. The five positions shall be identified as Positions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, and filings shall be by position. A special filing period shall be established as prescribed by the Records and Elections Division.

SECTION 6. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an

. 5	or effect, if the Boundary Review Board has not approved the proposed
