ORDINANCE NO.

20 -

AN ORDINANCE clarifying the rate of compensation paid to precinct election officials and amending Ordinance No. 918, Section 1 and Section 2, King County Code 1.08.010 and 1.08.020, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 918, Section 1, King County Code 1.08.010, is hereby amended as follows:

Precinct election officials shall be compensated at the (rate-of-\$1.60 per-hour,-the-minimum-hourly-wage-rate-as-established-by-state-law) then-prevailing federal minimum wage, except that at no time shall it be less than the state minimum wage.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 2.}}$ Ordinance No. 918, Section 2, King County Code 1.08.020, is hereby amended as follows:

The (director) manager of records and elections is authorized to compensate the inspectors, judges, and clerks at the then-prevailing federal minimum wage per hour the inspectors and judges and clerks attending (machine-and) voting devices instruction class shall be compensated for an additional two hours at the then-prevailing federal minimum hourly wage the inspectors shall be compensated an additional two hours at the then-prevailing federal minimum hourly wage, and the (Seattle-Inspector-picking-up-and-returning-the-election supplies) election official accompanying the inspector to the depot shall be entitled to additional compensation according to the (established-pay-zones of-\$1.003-\$2.003-and-\$3.00) then-prevailing federal minimum hourly wage, except that at no time shall it be less than the state minimum wage.

SECTION 3. This ordinance expires March 31, 1984.

SECTION 4. The King County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
