

ORDINANCE NO. 6558

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended by reclassifying the westerly 232 feet of certain property upon the application of IONA L. MUHICH, designated Building and Land Development File No. 238-83-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the September 16, 1983 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on October 6, 1983 on the application of Iona L. Muhich to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 238-83-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the westerly 232 feet of the subject property from SR (Potential BC) and SR (Potential RD 3600) to BC-P and deny requested RD 3600 for the balance of the subject property is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of Council approval, or any authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.


