ORDINANCE NO. 6566

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve subject to conditions (modified) the application for an unclassified use permit petitioned by CONSTRUCTORS PACIFIC COMPANY, ET AL, and designated Building and Land Development File No. 113-83-U.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

This Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its own findings and conclusions the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated July 27, 1983, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on August 11, 1983, to approve, subject to conditions (modified), the application for an unclassified use permit, petitioned by CONSTRUCTORS PACIFIC COMPANY, ET AL, designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development, File No. 113-83-U, and the Council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation contained in said report, with the following conditions revised to read:

- 16. Landscaping shall be provided in accordance with the Landscaping provisions of King County Code 21.51 (Landscaping Ordinance No. 5003) as amplified within the memorandum from the King County Planning Division dated 5/23/83 (Attachment C). Landscaping shall include evergreen trees at no more than 10 feet on center and no less than 12-24 inches at time of planting. Clustering of trees shall be permitted in order to avoid future removal of trees should the site be subsequently redeveloped for residential use. The entire site need not be reseeded, however all steep slopes (40%+) must be reseeded. Details to be worked out with the Building and Land Development Division.
- 28. No more than 80 loaded truck exits shall be permitted in any one day.
- 30. Conditions 28 and 29 above may be waived by the Building and Land Development Division to allow accelerated operations for a cumulative total of not more than 30 days per quarter of any year, provided that:
- (a) The permitee shall compensate King County for the actual

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cost of inspection during the waiver period.

- (b) The permittee shall make such provision for traffic safety such as flagman, warning signs, etc., as directed by the Building and Land Development Division.
- (c) The permittee shall notify affected parties by certified mail at least five days prior to commencement of the waiver period unless the Building and Land Development Division declares an emergency and waives this requirement. Such notices shall indicate the approximate length of the waiver period and the anticipated volume of extraction. Certified mail receipts shall be provided to the Building and Land Development Division upon their request.
- (d) The permittee shall obtain Surface Water Management Division approval that any increased extraction rates will not overload the storm drainage system.
