

ORDINANCE NO. 6572

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$657,483 to the Department of Human Resources; \$522,204 from the City of Seattle, suburban cities, and client payments and \$135,279 from Special Programs Executive Contingency to provide for constitutionally required legal defense services in accordance with KCC 2.60; amending Ordinance No. 6253, Sections 7 and 9, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$657,483 to the Department of Human Resources, \$522,204 of which shall be supported from unanticipated revenue, \$135,279 of which shall be supported from an appropriation from the Current Expense Fund Special Programs, Executive Contingency, for the purpose of providing constitutionally required legal defense services in accordance with KCC 2.60.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6253, Section 9, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 39. Human Resources. From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES (~~(\$4,835,757)~~) \$5,493,240

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 6253, Section 7, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 34. Special Programs. From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS (~~(\$4,018,784)~~) \$3,883,505




