AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$815,329 to the Public Health Pooling Fund from Federal grant funds, from the City of Seattle General Fund, and from the King County Current Expense Fund for various Public Health programs, and amending Ordinance No. 6213, Section 55, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$815,329 is hereby appropriated to the Public Health Pooling Fund for public health purposes from the following sources:

- A. \$137,960 from the City of Seattle General Fund;
- B. \$ 21,008 from the King County Current Expense Fund;
- C. \$540,875 from Federal grant revenues.
- D. \$115,486 from State grant revenues.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6213, Section 55, amended, is hereby amended as follows:

No more than ((342+9)) 348.1 FTE's shall be budgeted for Public Health Pooling.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
