- The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The Department of Public Works has found that the subject right of way and easement is located in the area of preliminary approved plats of Timber Hills Divisions No. 2 and 3 which will provide an acceptable alternate street pattern. The plats are ready for recording subject to the vacation of 200th Avenue S.E. The Department believes the public would be benefited by the finalizing of this vacation.
- No evidence was found that the vacation area has ever been open as a public road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is. therefore, classified "C" Class in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
