 ORDINANCE NO. 6627

AN ORDINANCE relating to King County Charter Section 530 and Personnel Policy Ordinance No. 4324; Establishing the 1983 and 1984 Salary Allocation List for Appointed Classifications, for Career Service Classifications, for Public Safety Civil Service Classifications, and Providing for Incentive Pay Increases; Repealing Ordinance No. 6142, and Ordinance No. 6603, Section 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6142 is hereby repealed.

- SECTION 2. In construing the provisions of this ordinance, except where otherwise declared or clearly apparent from the context, words used here shall be given their common and ordinary meaning. In addition, the following definitions shall apply:
- A. PAY PLAN A systematic schedule of numbered pay ranges with minimum, maximum and intermediate steps for each pay range, a schedule of assignment of each classification to a numbered pay range and rules for administration.
- B. INCENTIVE INCREASE An increase to an employee's base salary within the assigned pay range, based on demonstrated performance.
- C. POSITION A group of current duties and responsibilities assigned by competent authority requiring the full-time or part-time employment of one person.
- D. CLASSIFICATION PLAN The arrangement of positions into classifications together with specifications describing each classification.
 - CLASSIFICATION A position or group of positions,

established by authority, being sufficiently similar in respect to the duties, responsibilities and authority thereof, that the same descriptive title may be used to designate each position allocated to the classification. A new classification is required when factors of an existing classification cannot be applied to a position or group of positions.

- F. RECLASSIFICATION A change in the classification of a position to a higher, lower or equivalent classification on the basis of significant changes in the nature, difficulty and responsibility of duties assigned by competent authority.
- G. SALARY OR PAY RATE An individual dollar amount which is one of the steps in a pay range paid to an employee based on the classification of the position occupied.
- H. PAY RANGE One or more pay rates representing the minimum, maximum and intermediate steps assigned to a classification.
- I. PAY RANGE ADJUSTMENT The Adjustment of the numbered pay range of a classification to another numbered pay range in the schedule based on a classification change, competitive pay data or other significant factors.
- J. Y-RATE A pay rate that is in excess of the maximum of the pay range assigned to the classification of a position.

SECTION 3. The 1983 salary allocation list for appointed classifications set forth is hereby approved and adopted.

- d. Employees receiving incentive increases whose current salary does not coincide with a step on the pay plan shall be advanced to a step on the pay plan which shall be the next higher step after such incentive increase.
- C. An appointing authority may grant to an employee, an increase to a salary above the top step of the range if the following conditions are met:
 - 1. The employee is not a department director.

2. The employee must have been at the top step of the range for at least two consecutive years.

- 3. The employee must have demonstrated continuous outstanding performance, which must be supported by performance appraisal.
- 4. Written justification must be submitted to the Personnel Manager for approval.
- 5. Incentive increases above the top step may not exceed five percent, PROVIDED that, in no case shall the resultant annualized salary of an employee exceed ninety-five percent of his immediate supervisor's annualized salary.
- 6. Incentive increases above the top step will be in effect for twelve months only. Such increases must be justified each year by meeting the above specified conditions.
- D. Department directors shall not be prohibited from incentive pay increases but shall not be included in this ordinance.
- E. All within-range incentive increases are subject to the availability of funds. Within-range incentive increases are not automatic but shall be given only upon the affirmative action of the appointing authority within the guide-lines established by the Personnel Manager.

SECTION 14. The Personnel Manager shall have the responsibility and authority to reclassify any position to an existing or new classification, provided that any salary adjustments resulting from said reclassification shall not become effective until such time as the Budget Office certifies that sufficient funds are available, within the then existing appropriation of the department within which the position is being reclassified.

SECTION 15. The Personnel Manager may abolish, amend or create new classifications provided the assignment or reassignment of pay ranges to said classification shall be subject to the

provisions of Section 14 herein, provided further, the creation of any appointed classification, position, or reclassification of any appointed position, regardless of pay range or any pay range adjustments for positions exceeding range 54 or movements of four or more pay ranges for an existing classification or any pay range adjustment affecting two or more classifications in a classification series, shall be confirmed by the Operations, Police and Judiciary Committee prior to implementation.

SECTION 16. An employee who has a valid Washington State Professional Civil Engineering license, a registered Architect's license or a professional designation of CPA, MAI, RM, SSA, CPM or SR/WA, shall be paid an additional twenty-five dollars per month if such designation or professional license is a requirement of the job assignment.

SECTION 17. The administration of the pay provisions set forth herein will be the responsibility of the County Executive.

SECTION 18. Pay range assignments shall be subject to confirmation by ordinance by the King County Council at least annually.

SECTION 19. The provisions of a section of this ordinance, so far as they are substantially the same as those of a section of an ordinance existing at the time of their enactment, must be construed as a continuation thereof.
