

ORDINANCE NO. 6632

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$125,785 to the Division of Parks and Recreation from the Park Acquisition and Development Fund in the amount of \$98,216 and from the Current Expense Fund Special Programs, Executive Contingency in the amount of \$27,569; for the purpose of supporting additional staff for 1983 scheduled CIP projects and to provide for expenditures above the 1983 appropriation for self-sustaining recreation programs; amending Ordinance No. 6253, Sections 4 and 7, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$125,785 to the Division of Parks and Recreation from the Current Expense Fund Special Programs, Executive Contingency and from the Park Acquisition and Development Fund for support of the fee structured recreation program and additional staff for 1983 scheduled CIP projects.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6253, Section 4, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
