

ORDINANCE NO. 6673

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the standardized
3 Salary Schedule and the annual cost-of-
4 living increase for King County employees
5 as stipulated in K.C.C. 3.12.130 and K.C.C.
6 3.12.140; and Repealing Ordinance 6603,
7 Sections 2 and 3 and providing for cost-of-
8 living adjustments for the elected offices
9 of Prosecuting Attorney and Assessor.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6603, Sections 2 and 3 are hereby
12 repealed.

13 SECTION 2. The attached King County Standardized Salary
14 Schedule, entitled "Schedule of Pay Ranges and Steps in Annual,
15 Monthly, and Semi-Monthly Amounts and Hourly Rates," is approved
16 and adopted.

17 SECTION 3. Employees of the King County District Courts,
18 King County Superior Court, and the King County council, shall
19 have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent (1.5%)
20 effective January 1, 1984. This increase shall not apply to
21 elected officials, or those employees who are in a collective
22 bargaining unit whose labor agreement for 1984 has not been
23 settled, or to the District Court Administrator.

24 SECTION 4. Non-represented employees of the King County
25 prosecuting attorney's office shall be eligible to receive a
26 cost-of-living adjustment determined by the prosecuting
27 attorney, effective January 1, 1984. The amount to be applied
28 shall be determined by increasing the aggregate salary base in
29 effect prior to the effective date by an amount of one and
30 one-half percent (1.5%).

31 SECTION 5. Employees of the executive branch, non-elected
32 employees of the department of assessments, and employees of the
33 alcoholism and substance abuse, emergency medical services and
34 medical examiner divisions of the Seattle-King County department

1 of public health not included in collective bargaining units
2 shall have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent
3 (1.5%) effective January 1, 1984; except for employees holding
4 the rank of Captain in the department of public safety, those
5 holding the rank of Lieutenant in the department of adult
6 detention, those defined as first level supervisors in the
7 department of public works, and the airport security chief.
8 Captains in the department of public safety and Lieutenants in
9 the department of adult detention shall have their salaries
10 increased by the percentage increase accorded the police
11 bargaining unit for 1984. Assistant supervisors in the public
12 works department shall have their salaries increased by an
13 amount equivalent to that provided to equipment operator II
14 positions covered by the Construction Crafts agreement. The
15 airport security chief salary increase shall be that required to
16 maintain a 7.5% differential above the 1984 airport security
17 officer II annualized wage rate.

18 SECTION 6. Non-represented employees of the Seattle-King
19 County department of public health with the exception of those
20 employees of the alcoholism and substance abuse division,
21 emergency medical services division, the medical examiner
22 division, and those excluded by City of Seattle Ordinance
23 #111502 dated 12-23-83, shall have their salaries increased by
24 one and one-half percent (1.5%) plus twenty-five cents (.25) per
25 hour effective September 1, 1983.

26 SECTION 7. The elected office of the prosecuting attorney
27 shall receive a cost-of-living adjustment of one and one-half
28 percent (1.5) effective January 1, 1984 for an annual compen-
29 sation rate of \$66,332.

30 SECTION 8. The elected office of the King County Assessor
31 shall receive a cost of living adjustment of one and one-half
32 percent (1.5%) effective January 1, 1984 for an annual
33 compensation rate of \$60,451.

SECTION 9. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
