ORDINANCE NO. 6673

AN ORDINANCE relating to the standardized Salary Schedule and the annual cost-of-living increase for King County employees as stipulated in K.C.C. 3.12.130 and K.C.C. 3.12.140; and Repealing Ordinance 6603, Sections 2 and 3 and providing for cost-of-living adjustments for the elected offices of Prosecuting Attorney and Assessor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6603, Sections 2 and 3 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The attached King County Standardized Salary Schedule, entitled "Schedule of Pay Ranges and Steps in Annual, Monthly, and Semi-Monthly Amounts and Hourly Rates," is approved and adopted.

SECTION 3. Employees of the King County District Courts, King County Superior Court, and the King County council, shall have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent (1.5%) effective January 1, 1984. This increase shall not apply to elected officials, or those employees who are in a collective bargaining unit whose labor agreement for 1984 has not been settled, or to the District Court Administrator.

SECTION 4. Non-represented employees of the King County prosecuting attorney's office shall be eligible to receive a cost-of-living adjustment determined by the prosecuting attorney, effective January 1, 1984. The amount to be applied shall be determined by increasing the aggregate salary base in effect prior to the effective date by an amount of one and one-half percent (1.5%).

SECTION 5. Employees of the executive branch, non-elected employees of the department of assessments, and employees of the alcoholism and substance abuse, emergency medical services and medical examiner divisions of the Seattle-King County department

of public health not included in collective bargaining units 1 shall have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent 2 (1.5%) effective January 1, 1984; except for employees holding 3 the rank of Captain in the department of public safety, those holding the rank of Lieutenant in the department of adult 5 detention, those defined as first level supervisors in the 6 departent of public works, and the airport security chief. 7 Captains in the department of public safety and Lieutenants in 8 the department of adult detention shall have their salaries 9 increased by the percentage increase accorded the police 10 bargaining unit for 1984. Assistant supervisors in the public 11 works department shall have their salaries increased by an 12 amount equivalent to that provided to equipment operator II 13 positions covered by the Construction Crafts agreement. 14 airport security chief salary increase shall be that required to 15 maintain a 7.5% differential above the 1984 airport security 16 officer II annualized wage rate. 17 SECTION 6. Non-represented employees of the Seattle-King 18

SECTION 6. Non-represented employees of the Seattle-King County department of public health with the exception of those employees of the alcoholism and substance abuse division, emergency medical services division, the medical examiner division, and those excluded by City of Seattle Ordinance #111502 dated 12-23-83, shall have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent (1.5%) plus twenty-five cents (.25) per hour effective September 1, 1983.

SECTION 7. The elected office of the prosecuting attorney shall receive a cost-of-living adjustment of one and one-half percent (1.5) effective January 1, 1984 for an annual compensation rate of \$66,332.

SECTION 8. The elected office of the King County Assessor shall receive a cost of living adjustment of one and one-half percent (1.5%) effective January 1, 1984 for an annual compensation rate of \$60,451.

SECTION 9. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
