ORDINANCE NO. 6680

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Enumclaw Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On September 26, 1983, the City of Enumclaw filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On September 26, 1983, the City of Enumclaw passed Resolution No. B-375 adopting the City of Enumclaw Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On October 20, 1983, the City of Enumclaw completed its submittal of and adopted comprehensive water plan pursuant to KCC 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan and on November 9, 1983 recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Enumclaw Comprehensive Water System Plan as adopted by City Resolution No. B-375 (attached) is hereby approved.
