ORDINANCE NO. 6682

AN ORDINANCE approving amendants to the  
Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water  
District Comprehensive Sewer Facilities  
Plan and Comprehensive Water Plan.  
(Resolutions No. 1983-9-1 and 1983-9-2).

PREAMBLE:

On November 7, 1983, Northeast Lake Washington  
Sewer and Water District (NELWS&WD) passed  
Resolution No. 1983-11-2 adopting a Final  
Declaration of Non-Significance for proposed  
amendments to the district's water and sewer plans.

On September 6, 1983, Northeast Lake Washington  
Sewer and Water District passed Resolution No. 1983--  
9-1 adopting an amendment to the district's Compre-  
hensive Sewer Facilities Plan providing for a  
consolidated office complex.

On September 6, 1983, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer  
and Water District passed Resolution No. 1983-9-2  
adopting an amendment to the district's Comprehensive  
Water Plan providing for a consolidated office complex.

On December 5, 1983, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer  
and Water District completed its submittal of the  
amendments to King County pursuant to Chapters 56.08  
and 57.16 RCW and KCC Chapter 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical  
Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendments  
on November 9, 1983 and recommended conditional  
approval of the amendments.
