ORDINANCE NO. 6693

AN ORDINANCE relating to no shooting areas; establishing a no shooting area within portions of Cumberland and Green River voting precincts; adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.68.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.68 a new section to read:

Cumberland - Fish Lake - Green River. The shooting of firearms is prohibited and a no shooting area is established comprising the following legally described area:

All that portion of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 7 East, W.M., lying easterly of the east right-of-way margin of the Enumclaw-Franklin Road.

Together with the north 1/2 of Section 31, Township 21 North, Range 7 East, W.M.; EXCEPT that portion lying northwesterly of the southeasterly right-of-way margin of said Enumclaw-Franklin Road (aka County Road #1017), all situated in King County, Washington.
