## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of S.E. 64th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements have been granted to Puget Sound Power and Light Company and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company.
- 4. The petitioner has conveyed, as part of the consideration for the granting of subject vacation, lands for the right-of-way required for the construction of Vaughn Hill Road (East Lake Sammamish to D. H. Thomas Road).
- 5. In accordance with King County ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "A" Class. King County is now in receipt of \$9,500.00 from the petitioner which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for the vacation area as provided for under the negotiated terms of the conveyance for the right of way of Vaughn Hill Road.
- 6. The department of public works considers subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this surplus area to the public tax rolls.

7. The department of public works recommends that vacation of the area as described be granted on condition that King County retain all rights to the vacation area until completion and acceptance of the construction of the Vaughn Hill Road project.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the  $\cancel{1940}$  day of  $\cancel{1984}$ .

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition in accordance with the recommendations of the department of public works.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 19th day of March 19 14, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of S.E. 64th Street described as follows, reserving unto King County all rights in the vacated area until such time that the construction of the Vaughn Hill Road project is completed and accepted by King County:

That portion of Issaquah-Redmond Road, County Road No. 1011 Established 60 feet in width June 15, 1914 lying within the Southeast 1/4, Southeast 1/4, Section 21, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington, Lying Northeasterly of a line 50 feet Northeasterly of and parallel with the centerline of the Issaquah-Redmond Highway (East Lake Sammamish Parkway S.E.) and that portion Established as Issaquah-Monohan Revision May 4, 1931, Survey 27-24-6-1; and lying Northwesterly of a line 42 feet Northwesterly of an parallel with the centerline of the Vaughn Hill Road Established June 22, 1981 (Survey 27-24-6-10).

The vacation area contains approximately 19,000 square feet.
